Latest Jobs News

[This Irish Oscar-nominated animation company is bringing 140 new jobs to Kilkenny](#)

THERE WAS GOOD news on the jobs front in Kilkenny and Waterford recently with a total of 200 new roles announced between the two counties. Of these, 140 will be coming to the newly-created Lighthouse Studios in Kilkenny. A joint venture between locally-based animation studio Cartoon Saloon and Canadian firm Mercury Filmworks, Lighthouse Studios will focus on 2D animation, with a dash of CGI thrown in. Development and production projects will commence in the coming weeks, and the company are looking for designers, animators, effects artists, composers, technical directors, 3D modelers, riggers, lighting and texture artists, and IT administrators. Cartoon Saloon's CEO Paul Young said that Ireland enjoys a "number of advantages" in the field of animation, and that the country had a wealth of talent in the area at its disposal.

The company has produced Irish animations such as The Secret of Kells and The Song of The Sea, both of which were nominated for best animated feature at the Oscars in 2010 and 2015, respectively.

Open source software provider Red Hat also had good news on the job front today, investing €12.7 million and committing to the creation of another 60 jobs in Waterford over the next four years.

[Recruitment of 140 civilian Garda staff announced](#)

140 new civilian recruits are to be taken on by the summer 2017. This initial batch will be deployed in the national specialist units, and in desk duties, enabling fully trained Gardaí to be transferred from desk jobs, back to policing duties. An estimated 50 Gardaí will be released. Recruitment of civilian staff to An Garda Síochána is mainly carried out in association with the [Public Appointments Service](#).

Recruitment takes the form of either general civil service open competitions or special competitions for particular professional or senior managerial positions. Details of upcoming recruitment competitions are advertised on the "Current Jobs" page of the Public Appointments Service website which is updated weekly.

[20 new research jobs for Mayo and major investment for Marine Institute](#)

An Taoiseach Enda Kenny TD has announced the creation of 20 new jobs and a €6 million investment for the **Marine Institute** at its research facility in Newport, Co Mayo.

The new positions will be based at the Newport base, where they will be engaged on a number of research projects funded from the €6 million in research grants.

[100 jobs for Shannon with Element Six](#)

*One hundred new jobs have been announced for industrial diamond manufacturing company **Element Six** in Clare.*

Element Six is a member of the De Beers Group of Companies. It produces synthetic diamond super-materials. The investment was officially announced today at a briefing hosted by Element Six Executive Director of Operations Ken Sullivan. It was attended by Minister of State at the Department of Jobs, Enterprise and Innovation Pat Breen and the company's global CEO Mr. Walter Hühn.

The new positions are part of a €7million expansion of the company's operation in Shannon. The vacancies are in the areas of:

- Supply Chain
- Engineering and
- Manufacturing

It is expected the 100 jobs will be filled by the first half of this year, with the recruitment process already underway. The new jobs will bring the Element Six workforce in Shannon to 550 - more than double since the implementation of a major restructuring plan in 2009.
