

Frequency of Social Networking Website Access




no difference between boys and girls in terms of the frequency that they were accessing these sites.

Time Spent on Social Networking Websites




Girls appear to be engaging in longer sessions.



Favourite Features?




Comments are their favourite feature, it was more popular with girls. Boys seem to favour video content where girls preferred photos.



Public or Private




'Private' is a dubious concept.

Have you accepted as 'friends' people who you have NOT met before?




'Private' is a flawed concept. Three quarters have 'friends' they have never met.



Why are Social Networking sites Popular with young people?

- Free
- Easy to use
- Useful for Key life events for teenagers
 - establishing independent identity
 - Socialisation
- A place free from Adult Supervision. There is less opportunity to hang-out with peers offline.

Myth busting: Bebo = The Best/Worst Thing Ever

- Moral Panic - Paedophiles, porn, addictive
- Techno-Evangelists - transforming + revolutionary.
- Just another tool to make their lives easier.
- Risks are real and some children have negative experiences online but most don't.
- Key = understanding children's digital lives

Advice

- DO NOT respond to the message as this will only make things worse
- DO keep a record of the message so that the problem can be dealt with properly
- DO block the sender
- Report it!
- DO talk to someone in authority about what has happened
